1. Rules

1.1 The organizing authority is the Columbia Sailing Club (CSC).

1.2 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in **“The Racing Rules of Sailing”** (RRS 2017-2020) and event Sailing Instructions.

1.3. A PFD shall be worn by all competitors while sailing.

2. Eligibility and Entry

2.1 This regatta is open to members of the Columbia Sailing Club. Crew and skipper both have to be members unless crew/skipper is a member’s child under 22 years of age or spouse of member. With limited boats there will be limited entries. The date registered with full payment will be considered as the deciding factor if more crews apply than are boats available. All attempts to secure extra boats will be made but cannot be guaranteed.

2.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the Entry Form and sending it along with the appropriate fees to the Organizing Authority, as follows:

3. Fees Entry Form Attached.

3.1 Registration Fee: \$50. The Entry Form and Registration Fee must be received by **April 28th, 2017**. Payment must be received to be registered.

3.2 Profits from the Regatta will be contributed to the Columbia Sailing Club Youth Program

5 Yachts Utilized

The Regatta will be sailed in Club 420s owned by the Columbia Sailing Club. A rotation will be utilized.

6. Sailing Instructions - Sailing Instructions (SI) will be available the day of registration.

7. Courses & Racing Area - Racing area is eastern end of Lake Murray. Courses will be described in the SI.

8. Scoring:

8.1 A minimum of one (1) race must be completed to constitute a regatta.

8.2 Scoring shall be based on the 2017-2020 RRS, Appendix A.

9 Trophies

There will be three trophies, first, second and third, presented. The helmsman of the winning yacht shall be deemed Columbia Sailing Club “Club Champion” for the year. Winning skipper/crew may represent CSC in SAYRA club championships.

Competitors participate in the regatta in the regatta *entirely* at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with prior to, during, or after the regatta.
