BACK COVE UPDATE

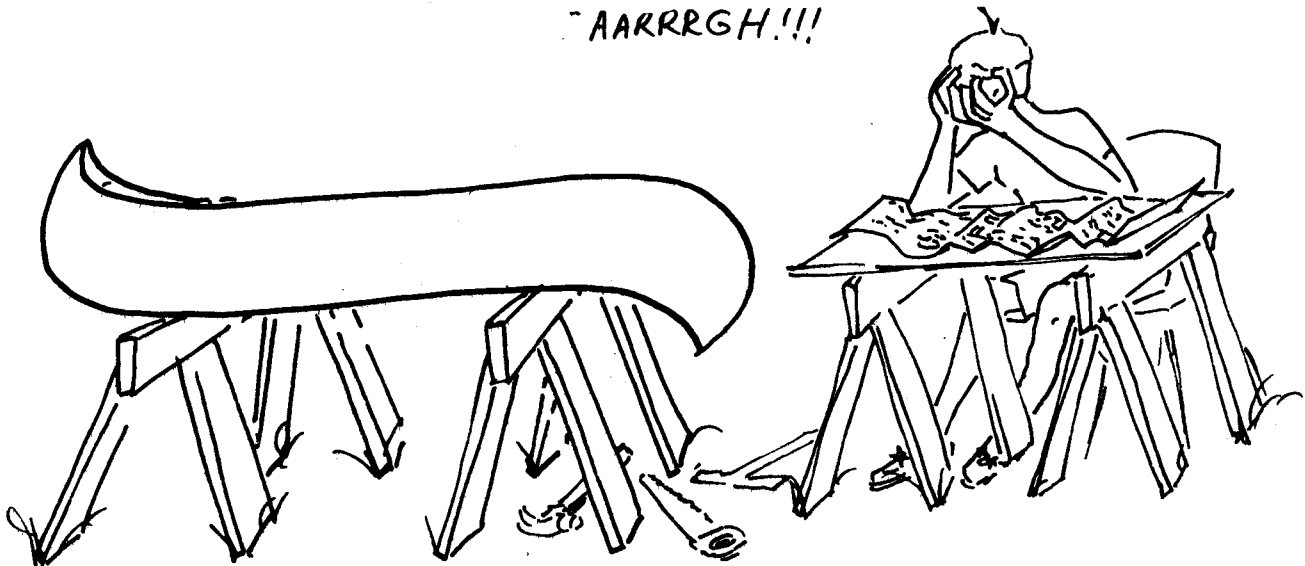
At the time of this writing, Feb. 13, we have passed our initial target date for restoring the docks to the backcove. The weather and the "I told you so rock" have substantially slowed down progress, but we have made progress. The rock has been blasted and the majority of it removed. The weather is now our biggest remaining concern. Unfortunately, as I look out the window, it is raining.

Barring more bad weather or some new, unexpected problem, our current estimate for putting the docks back is around April 1. The plan as to how to put the docks back and anchor them is now being finalized.

In the meantime, we are having 4 new dock sections constructed for #2 front dock. The old sections of #2 will be brought around to the back and used as runners for new slips. Also, 10 new slip fingers are being built for these runners so that approximately 20 new slips can be quickly created for our waiting list.

Those of us handling the details of this project appreciate your patience.

New Provisional members are John R. Williams, M.D., Donald W. Baxter, and Paul Niebauer.

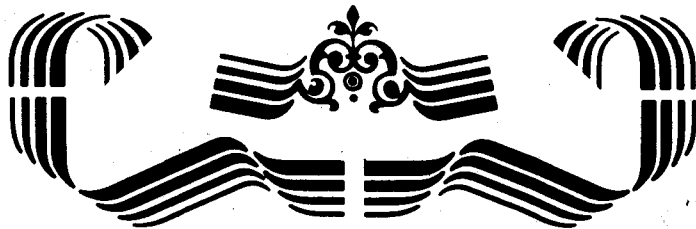
Red Otterbacher was proposed for Honorary Membership.

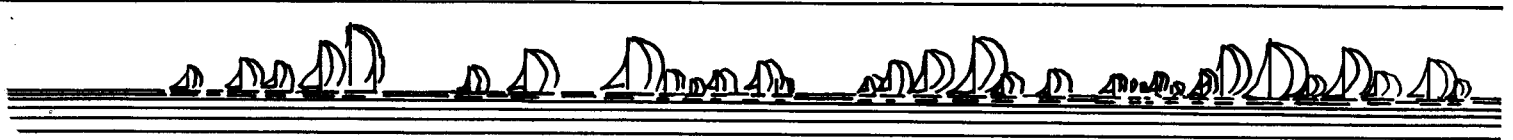

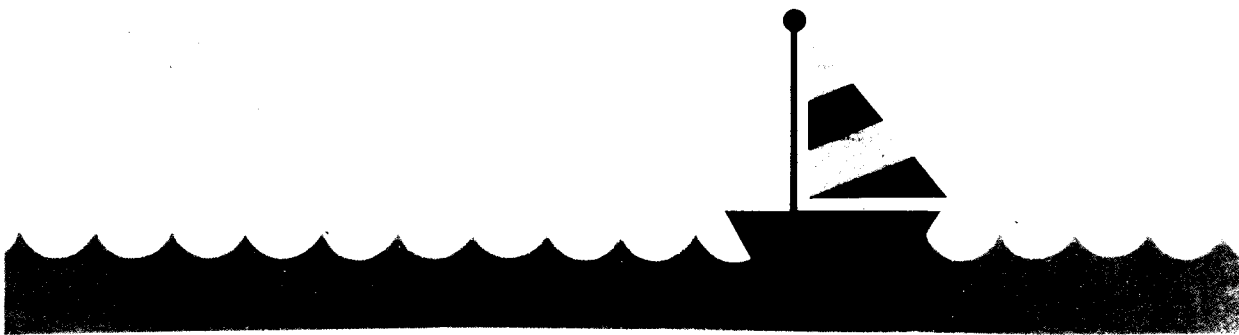
